Dear Otter & Otter-pup families,

Hopefully everyone had a great holiday season! Thank you for all who were able to make it to our Winter Party. The Otters and Otter-pups worked really hard on their performances. And I know they were eager to eat the fudge that they helped make for the party!

For the winter break, we went on a few field trips. We went to Putters for mini-golf, saw a magic show at the Springfield Library, and went on a winter nature walk at Delta Ponds. What a great group of kiddos to take on outings! They all do such a fantastic job at following directions and have such fun attitudes.

The Otter-pups and Springfield Otters also got to go on a field trip to the Natural and Cultural Museum at the U of O. What a great trip! They have really expanded their exhibits there and have a lot of hands-on activities for kiddos to do. There were many exhibits on the Native American history of Oregon and also pre-historic and modern animals of the Pacific Northwest.

Our Otter-pups are eager and ready to learn, and they are a very motivated and determined group this year. They have set some great goals for them selves to reach this year. When we first asked the children what they would like to learn this year, they answered very enthusiastically that they would like to learn to read chapter books. As we have been working on sounds and letters, they have been showing a great understanding of what is going on. This shows that they will reach their ambitious goal at some point in the future... but they will probably not be reading chapter books by the end of kindergarten!



They do an excellent job of sounding out words and trying to read them. Your kindergarten child should be bringing a book home a few times a month from our reading lessons that they can read to you. Our most recent letter we have been working with is the letter "F". We have practiced listening for it by reading words in sentences and having the children clap when they hear the sound.

We wanted to let families know about our 'Odds and ends' shelf in the classroom. This is a shelf of items that can be used for crafts that would normally get thrown out in the trash or recycling. The students like to browse this shelf for items to create many different crafts. If you come across small items at home that you are going to get rid of (and that are clean) but could be used for unique craft projects, feel free to bring them to the Otter class. These items could be things like t.p. or paper towel tubes, yogurt containers, packaging peanuts, container lids, small boxes, and the list could go on!

One last note- we wanted to give you a friendly reminder to make sure to contact us if your child will not be at Unity, especially if we normally pick them up from school. Thank you and please don't hesitate to talk to us if you have any questions or concerns!
